

Call for Article Submissions

Special Theme Issue: *Action Research and the Arts*

Initial Proposal to Submit: before July 1, 2021

Submission Deadline: October 31, 2021

The *Canadian Journal of Action Research* invites you to submit an article for our upcoming theme issue focusing on “Action Research and the Arts”. The catalyst for this invitation is linked to Dr. Rita Irwin’s upcoming keynote address “Walking with A/r/tography” at the 2021 Canadian Association of Action Research in Education conference highlighting the intertwined connections between action research, the arts, education, and arts-based approaches to research.

In this special issue we will publish action research studies in, on, about, or through the arts in education, including dance, drama, literary arts, media, music, visual arts, or studies that integrate these arts areas. *CJAR* is published electronically which allows for musical scores, visual art works, audio files, video clips, photographs, graphics, and so on to be embedded into the written text. Alternative forms of text should be sent in *jpeg* or *gif* format. Please name and number the images and insert instructions for embedding them into the text of the manuscript submission (e.g., Insert Audio File 1 [Students composing melodies using guitars] here.).

- A submission of about 6,000 words (excluding references) that follows APA 7th style
- An accompanying 100 word abstract
- A separate file that includes authorship information

Additional Optional Feature: If you wish to discuss your work in open forum, you may do so as part of an earmarked workshop at the CAARE conference as part of the 2021 Canadian Society for the Study of Education conference.
