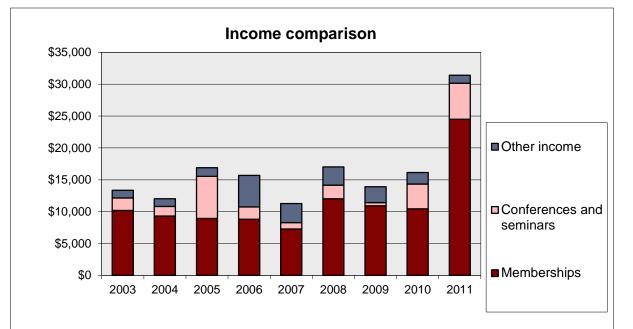

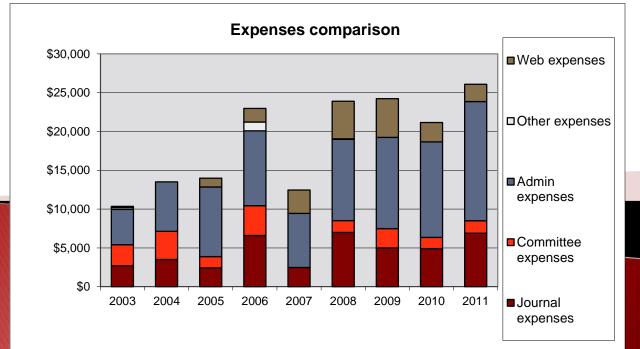

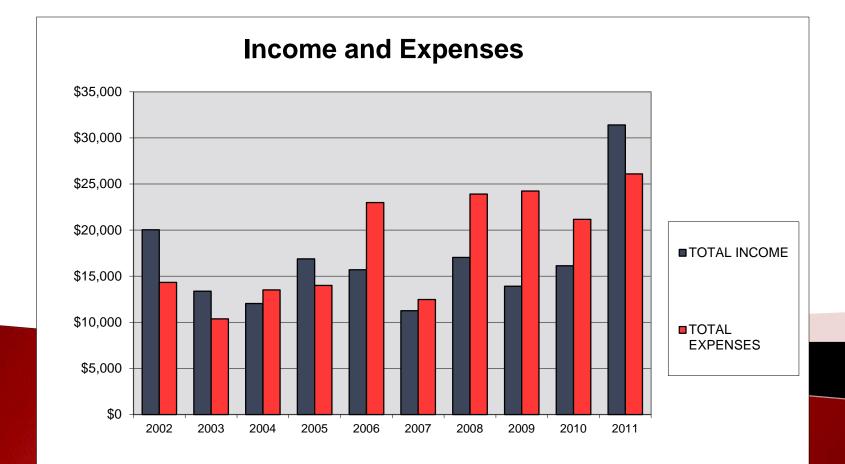
Treasurer's Report Balance sheet history 2003 to 2011
